BAWDSEY COMMUNITY AREA

The decision of the District Council to formally hand over the Amenity Area to the Parish Council will take place on 3 March. In the meantime the Working Group is busy preparing funding applications to build the new visitor centre. We've just heard that we are to be paid a grant of £8,000 from the Suffolk Empowering Communities Fund and on 26 January the District Council will decide on our applications for revenue and capital grants totalling £14,000. An application for just over £100,000 is about to be submitted to the Reaching Communities Buildings Fund, part of The Big Lottery.
